Welcome to Morning Kindergarten Enrichment! What an exciting year ahead for us .We began our month getting to know all our classmates by discussing one thing to like about me! They had a lot of giggles and fun taking turns with this game.

Beach week was fun for the class. The students had a chance to speak about their vacations and their knowledge of the local beaches. We read Fish Eyes, Rainbow Fish and Swimmy. We made a jelly fish and practiced counting with the tentacles!!

Apple week was all about the different types of apples that we see during the fall season. They heard the story about Johnny Appleseed and what a kind and gentle man he was. We had a contest to see which flavor apple was our favorite. Green apples won by a land slide!!! Red and Yellow apples tied for 2nd place!. The best part of apple week is eating so many apples. This class really loves apples! We read a story called "The Little Red House without Doors". The class was amazed at the star shape inside the apple after it was cut open! We also used

watercolor to make beautiful stain glass apples for our class room windows.

The first day of fall was all about the different changing colors. The students enjoyed painting a fall tree using crumbled up newspaper!!! A different medium for painting to show them how to use their imagination! We did several art pieces with the beautiful colors of fall.

Bats were are subject for Bb week! The boys and girls learned various facts about these creatures. The class made butter for Bb week and sampled it on saltine crackers. We also read Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We also played a balloon relay race for a little added fun to our Bb week!!

The students are very excited about participating in bringing words that begin with the letter of the week. The class also like playing the Dictionary Game. They love guessing the words to the definitions. We will be doing this every Thursday.

Our class will continue practicing identifying capital letters vs. lower case letter. They are now trying to print their names starting with the capital followed by lower case letters.

The transition went very smooth for this class. All students have adapted to our schedule and riding the bus after Trinity to their designated Kindergarten!!

Afternoon Enrichment:

Welcome to Kindergarten Enrichment! We've been settling into our routine and enjoying the beautiful weather outside. The children love going to their specials—Gym, Yoga, and Geography.

In the classroom, we've been playing games that help us practice letters and numbers. Some favorites include hide-and-seek with letters and numbers.

Art is always a highlight of the week! We explored mosaics by creating our own name mosaics, and then we combined science and art by painting with bubbles. We also studied Paul Cézanne's still life, *Three Apples in a Wooden Bowl*, and created our own versions using oil pastels and watercolors.

On September 15, we celebrated International Dot Day—a day that encourages creativity and self-

expression. Inspired by Kandinsky's circle artwork and the book *The Dot* by Peter H. Reynolds, we asked the question: "*What can you make with a dot?*" The creativity of our young artists was amazing! We also welcomed the new season by making leaf prints.

We have been reviewing our letter sounds, beginning with:

A is for Apple – we tasted red and green apples, then voted for our favorite. Red won!

B is for Band-Aid – we made our own Band-Aid books.

C is for Cookie – we enjoyed cookie-themed fun.

STEM has been a big part of our learning too! We discovered we have many future engineers in our class. The children built towers with pool noodles, blocks, and cups—working together to plan and design. Of course, knocking them down was just as fun as building them up! We also designed paper airplanes and had a friendly competition to see which could fly the farthest. The children concluded that distance depended on the wings and the way the airplane was thrown.

We've had a wonderful start to the year, and next month we're looking forward to exploring **autumn and Halloween themes**. We can't wait!
